### **HEAD LICE, THEY'RE BACK!!**

We have had a large number of reported cases of head lice. It is that time of the year where they are out in full force and don't discriminate who they attach themselves to. I ask that parents check their children's hair daily. This helps us stay on top of them multiplying and spreading.

### **CHILDREN WITH LIVE LICE.**

If children have live lice, **please keep them at home until free of live lice.** It's important to treat each individual member of the family, to ensure they're free of any live lice, prior to return to school. You will need to re-treat hair in 4 days time. This ensures any eggs that have been missed don't hatch and start the cycle off again.

If your child has head lice, please notify Mrs Stavrou so she can arrange a whole class head lice check.

If you need any support/assistance in dealing with head lice, please feel free to make a time and come and speak to me.
